You must finalize your activities and information and submit this report during the submission period of June 7 - June 30, any SOG requirements (400 pts) missing can result in NO RECOGNITION. You must submit your final report no later than June 30, after that no changes will be allowed.

This tool also serves as your chapter's required annual report. The submission period is June 7 - June 30, during which time a submit button will appear on the final review page. Click submit after you have reviewed and verified all your information and no later than June 30.






#### **Areas of Focus this Term**

- Including VPs, as well as Presidents, in all meetings & trainings


